Dear Sir,

The Government of Lesotho, is desirous of continuing to apply within its territory, on a basis of reciprocity the terms of the following agreement for a period of twelve months from the date of Lesotho's independance:

- 1. Air Service Agreement<sup>2</sup>
- $\mathbf{2}$ . Consular Convention <sup>3</sup>
- 3. Extradition Treaty 4
- Convention relating to Tenure and Disposition of Real and Personal 4. Property 5 (as amended) 6
- Declaration Affording Reciprocal Protection to Trade marks<sup>7</sup> 5.
- Visa Agreements of 1937 and 1948<sup>8</sup> 6.

For the above stipulated period of twelve months, I propose that the above-mentioned treaties be considered as continuing in force between our two government unless terminated in accordance with their provisions, or unless replaced by mutual agreement.
