AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE KINGDOM OF GREECE AND THE SYRIAN ARAB REPUBLIC FOR THE AVOIDANCE OF DOUBLE TAXATION ON INCOME DERIVING FROM MARITIME AND AIR TRANSPORT OPERATIONS

The Government of the Syrian Arab Republic and the Government of the Kingdom of Greece, desiring to avoid the double taxation of income deriving from operations in international traffic, have agreed on the following provisions:

Article I

Income deriving from the operation of ships in international traffic shall be taxable only in the Contracting State in whose territory the said ships are registered or which has provided them with certificates of registry.

Article II

Income deriving from the operation of aircraft in international traffic shall be taxable only in the Contracting State in which the headquarters of the actual management of the enterprise are situated.

Article III

This Agreement shall be ratified or approved, in accordance with the constitutional provisions of each Contracting Party, and shall enter into force on the date of the exchange of diplomatic notes to that effect.

The provisions of this Agreement shall apply to the income earned as from 1 January of the year in which the instruments of ratification are exchanged.

This Agreement may be denounced by either Contracting Party at six months' notice. In such event, it shall cease to have effect with regard to the income earned in any financial or accounting year beginning after the date of expiry.
