EXCHANGE OF LETTERS CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND MAURITIUS FOR THE APPLICATION AS BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF MAURITIUS OF THE AGREEMENT OF 27 JUNE 1963² BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND FOR THE PROVISION OF OPERATIONAL, EXECUTIVE AND ADMINISTRATIVE PERSONNEL TO THE TRUST, NON-SELF-GOVERNING AND OTHER TERRITORIES FOR WHOSE INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM ARE RESPONSIBLE

Sir,

I am writing on behalf of the United Nations Development Programme and have the honour to propose that, following the independence of Mauritius on 12 March 1968 and until such time as a standard agreement for the provision of operational assistance is signed between the Government of Mauritius and the United Nations Development Programme, both the Government of Mauritius and the United Nations Development Programme will apply the provisions of the Agreement for the provision of Operational and Executive Personnel, signed on 27 June 1963,² between the United Nations and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, acting on behalf of the Trust, Non Self-Governing and other Territories for whose international relations the Government of the United Kingdom is responsible.
