### AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup> BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THE NETHERLANDS AND THE GOV-ERNMENT OF PAKISTAN CONCERNING A MOTIVA-TION RESEARCH PROJECT IN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE PAKISTAN FAMILY PLANNING SCHEME

The Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands and the Government of Pakistan,

desirous of strengthening the ties of friendship existing between their nations and of promoting good relations between their countries generally;

recognizing the necessity to contribute to the solution of the problem of the rapid population growth in the world in general and more specifically in Pakistan;

determined to further the successful execution of the Family Planning Scheme of Pakistan,

have agreed as follows :

#### Article 1

1. The two Governments shall collaborate in undertaking sociological research in Pakistan of which the results may contribute to the successful implementation of the Pakistan Family Planning Scheme.

The project will especially be designed to gather data relating to the progress of the Pakistan Family Planning Programme among the local population and how the attitude towards family planning in the local level changes in this respect, inter alia with a view to contribute to the improvement of the various means of motivation.

2. To this end the Government of Pakistan shall assist a Netherlands team of sociologists to conduct such a research by designating an equal number of social workers to be associated with this team; by putting at the disposal of the Netherlands team office and storage facilities and by arranging for appropriate integration of the Netherlands project into the Pakistan Family Planning Scheme.

3. The Netherlands Government shall contribute to the project by making available expert assistance, equipment and fellowships during a period of about

twelve months in first instance; which period can be extended up to a maximum of three years as will be decided upon by the competent authorities of both Governments.

#### Article 2

The collaboration of the two Governments concerning this motivation research project shall be defined and specified by an administrative agreement hereinafter called the "Plan of Operations" to be concluded hereafter by the competent authorities of both the Governments.

#### Article 3

1. The Government of Pakistan shall take all necessary steps for the clearance and temporary storage in the port of arrival in Pakistan and the transportation from there to the area where the research will take place of the equipment and other goods, required in connection with the project, that are made available by the Netherlands Government.

2. The costs of clearance, storage and transport, including insurance, import and export duties and any other taxes in respect of the equipment and other goods required in connection with the research, that are made available by the Netherlands Government shall be borne by the Government of Pakistan.

#### Article 4

1. Experts made available by the Netherlands Government in conformity with the Plan of Operations will be entitled to the facilities described in the *Office Memorandum* Nr. IV (18) C.2/62 of July 7, 1965 of the Economic Affairs Division of the President's Secretariat of the Government of Pakistan.

2. The experts made available by the Netherlands Government shall be exempt from Pakistan taxes and other legal deductions and duties on the salaries and allowances which are paid to them during their assignment to the project.

#### Article 5

1. If a third party brings a legal action in a court of Law for any damage caused to him by a Netherlands Expert in connection with the execution of a task assigned to that Expert under the present agreement, and obtains a decree or order for compensation, the Government of Pakistan shall pay the compensation for and on behalf of the Netherlands Expert to that third party. The relationship between the Government of Pakistan and the Netherlands Expert shall be that of a master and servant with respect to the performance of the task assigned to the Expert under this agreement, and the liability of the Government of Pakistan

to pay compensation for and on behalf of the Netherlands Expert shall be governed by paragraph 3 of this Article.

2. Notwithstanding paragraph 1 of this article, the Government of Pakistan shall pay compensation for and on behalf of a Netherlands Expert for a claim which is settled out of court, provided that the Government of Pakistan is a party to such settlement.

3. Notwithstanding the legal foundation of such claim the Netherlands Expert shall not be liable to reimburse the Government of Pakistan except where the damage caused to the third party, for which compensation is awarded by the court or settled out of court, is due to the gross negligence of the Netherlands Expert.

The Government of the Netherlands shall render all possible assistance to the Pakistani authorities for the enforcement of claims of reimbursement.

#### Article 6

1. This Agreement shall take effect on the day on which the Netherlands Government and the Government of Pakistan have informed each other in writing that the procedures constitutionally required in their respective countries have been complied with.

2. This Agreement shall expire four years after the date of signature.

3. Notwithstanding the contents of paragraph 1 of this Article, this Agreement shall provisionally be applied as from the date of signature.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the undersigned, duly authorized thereto signed the present Agreement.
