AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup> BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF DENMARK AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF SWEDEN CONCERNING THE EXCHANGE OF MILITARY INFORMATION AND EQUIPMENT

---

The Government of the Kingdom of Denmark and the Government of the Kingdom of Sweden deem it desirable to promote the development, production, procurement, etc. of military equipment by such means as reciprocal and joint purchases where possible.

For that purpose the two Governments shall, as necessary, empower the appropriate authorities to supply to one another such military information and equipment as will create the necessary conditions for joint procurement, development, etc.

The supply of secret military information or equipment shall be governed by the following rules:

- (a) The information and equipment received may not be transferred to a third party without the consent of the country of origin;
- (b) The information and equipment received shall be afforded at least the same degree of security protection in the receiving country as in the country of origin;
- (c) The information and equipment received may not be used for any purpose other than that for which it is intended.

Proprietary rights such as patents, copyright or trade secrets attaching to the military information and equipment supplied shall be respected and protected in accordance with the laws in force.

Detailed procedures for the supply and handling of military information and equipment in the proposed exchange shall be set out in a separate agreement between the competent authorities of the two countries.

This Agreement may be reviewed at any time at the request of either Government and shall cease to have effect six months after one of the Governments denounces it in writing to the other Government. Such denunciation shall not, however, affect any obligations arising out of the provisions of the Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the undersigned, being duly authorized for the purpose by their respective Governments, have signed this Agreement and have thereto affixed their seals.

DONE at Stockholm on 11 September 1970, in duplicate in the Danish and Swedish languages, both texts being equally authentic.
