CONVENTION ¹ CONCLUDED IN IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENT OF 28 JULY 1965 ² CONCERNING THE CONTRIBUTION BY THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT TO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF THE ALGERIAN PETROLEUM INSTITUTE AND DETERM-INING FOR THE PERIOD FROM 1 OCTOBER 1969 TO 30 SEPTEMBER 1970 THE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE ASSISTANCE PROVIDED BY THE FRENCH GOVERN-MENT

The Government of the French Republic and

The Government of the Democratic and Popular Republic of Algeria,

Considering the programme of activities of the Algerian Petroleum Institute for the period from 1 October 1969 to 30 September 1970 and the technical and teaching personnel requirements for this period as indicated on 18 November 1969 by the Director General of the Algerian Petroleum Institute and set forth in annex I,

Have agreed as follows:

1. The two Governments express their desire to continue their cooperation in training personnel for petroleum operations, in particular through the French Petroleum Institute, which shall continue to assist the Algerian Petroleum Institute in strengthening its technical and educational staff and enabling it to carry out certain research operations.

For the period from 1 October 1969 to 30 September 1970, co-operation between the two Governments shall take the following forms:

- Making available to the Algerian Petroleum Institute engineers and technicians to meet the requirements itemized in annex I and any subsequent requirements;
- Seconding to the Algerian Petroleum Institute volunteers of the active national service;

- Making available to the Algerian Petroleum Institute teachers for shortterm teaching assignments;
- Offering the benefit of the experience acquired by the French Petroleum Institute and, *inter alia*, organizing individual technical advisory missions;

Organizing public lectures;

Providing training in France for pupils, engineers or technicians from the Algerian Petroleum Institute.

The French staff serving at the Algerian Petroleum Institute shall enjoy the benefit of the provisions of Decree No. 67-168 of 24 August 1967 concerning foreign appointees serving in Algeria under technical and cultural co-operation agreements.

2. The French Government shall assume responsibility for the following services:

- Making available to the Algerian Petroleum Institute engineers and technicians to fill the technical and teaching posts itemized in annex II;
- Sending teachers from France for short-term teaching assignments;
- Offering the benefit of the experience acquired by the French Petroleum Institute and, *inter alia*, organizing special technical advisory missions;

Organizing public lectures.

3. The Algerian Government shall assume responsibility for the expenses arising out of the following services:

Making available to the Algerian Petroleum Institute personnel and technicians to fill technical and teaching posts not included in annex II;

Services of local teachers;

- Accomodation and travel of all engineers and technicians made available to the Algerian Petroleum Institute;
- The costs of providing training in France for pupils, engineers and technicians from the Algerian Petroleum Institute.

The arrangements for implementing this Convention shall be stipulated in an agreement to be concluded between the Caisse centrale de coopération économique, acting for and on behalf of the French Government, and the Algerian Petroleum Institute.
