AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE
KINGDOM OF DENMARK AND THE GOVERNMENT
OF THE UNITED REPUBLIC OF TANZANIA ON THE
ESTABLISHMENT OF AN AUDIO-VISUAL INSTITUTE
IN DAR ES SALAAM

The Government of the Kingdom of Denmark (hereinafter referred to as the “ Government of Denmark ”) and the Government of the United Republic of Tanzania (hereinafter referred to as the “ Government of Tanzania ”) being desirous of strengthening the friendly relations between the two countries and their people and recognizing their mutual interest in the economic and technical development of their countries have agreed as follows:

ESTABLISHMENT AND OBJECTIVES

Article I

The Government of Denmark and the Government of Tanzania will jointly establish and operate under the terms and conditions stipulated by this Agreement and such other provisions as may be agreed upon an Audio-Visual Institute at Dar es Salaam, hereafter referred to as “ the Institute ”. The Institute shall fulfil the following objectives:

- (a) producing audio-visual educational material for ministries and other government institutions which have a requirement for audio visual productions serving national development objectives.

The Institute will during the build-up period of four years undertake only 16 mm educational black and white film production and utilization and with regard to other visual aid productions act as adviser for the co-ordination of productions already undertaken in various government institutions in Tanzania.

- (b) providing for the Government of Tanzania a Central Government Film Library and a repair and maintenance workshop for servicing 16 mm sound film projectors and other visual aid equipment.
- (c) training Tanzanian film experts in the subject dealt with by the Institute.

Article II

(a) Subject to the provisions of Article I (a) of the Agreement the Institute will be established as a separate and autonomous unit within the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting.

(b) The Government of Tanzania will as soon as possible after the signing of this agreement enact the legislation covering the organizational structure of the Institute in accordance with this agreement.

CONTRIBUTIONS IN KIND AND CASH

Article III

The Government of Denmark undertakes to provide the following contributions to the Institute:

(a) to recruit and pay salaries, international travel expenses and insurance for the Danish staff referred to in Article V (a) of this Agreement up to D. kr. 1.429.000

(b) to provide the following:

(i) motion picture equipment of high international standard	1.244.000
(ii) air-conditioning of the Institute	112.500
(iii) cost of packing, shipment and insurance of equipment from suppliers to Dar es Salaam	37.500
(iv) a contingency operating fund	127.000
	Total D. kr. 2.950.000

Article IV

The Government of Tanzania undertakes to provide the following contributions to the Institute:

(a) to recruit and pay salaries and all other expenses for the Tanzanian staff referred to in Article V (b), including medical and social services, etc.;

- (b) to provide a suitable building to house the Institute during its build-up period, the approximate area of accommodation for the building to be 5,750 square feet;
- (c) subject to the provisions of the Agreement on Scientific and Technical Co-operation between the Government of Denmark and the Government of Tanzania to provide suitable accommodation for the Danish staff and their families;
- (d) to pay all other costs which are required for the proper operation of the Institute, and which are not listed among Denmark's commitments under article III;
- (e) to allow the importation into Tanzania of all equipment paid by Denmark in pursuance of Article III free of import duties, customs duties, sales tax, and other charges;
- (f) to transfer to the Institute the means of transportation and 16 mm film equipment from the existing Tanzanian film unit.

ADMINISTRATION AND ORGANIZATION

Article V

The Institute will be staffed as follows:

- (a) Danish Staff:
 - (i) During the four years of build-up period a Chief Technical Adviser/Project Manager;
 - (ii) During the first three years of build-up period a Motion Picture Screen Writer/Director/Cameraman/Editor;
 - (iii) During the first two years of build-up period a Laboratory Processing and Printing Technician.
- (b) Tanzanian Staff to be provided according to the time schedule in the protocol A attached to this Agreement:
 - (i) A Director of the Institute as Counterpart Project Manager;
 - (ii) An administrative executive officer, an accountant, two clerical officers, a translator and three stenographers/typists;
 - (iii) Six film directors/writers;

- (iv) An executive producer in charge of production, four film editors (positive-negative film), four cameramen, four assistant cameramen, a sound recordist and mixer, three sound assistants, three laboratory technicians, a repairman (equipment), a projectionist, two librarians, two audio-visual experts and an electrician.
- (v) Services staff:
Two drivers, two messengers, two charmen and two watchmen.

Article VI

Subject to the provisions of Article VII (c) the Director of the Institute shall control and manage all activities, affairs and funds of the Institute. The Director of the Institute will during the build-up period of four years consult the Chief Technical Adviser/Project Manager in all matters regarding the Institute.

Article VII

As soon as possible after the signing of this agreement a Board shall be set up for the Institute.

(a) The Board shall be composed as follows:

- (i) Representatives for Tanzania representing
Ministry of Information and Broadcasting
The Tanganyika African National Union (TANU)
The Ministry of National Education
The Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Co-operatives

The Ministry of Regional Administration and Rural Development
The Ministry of Health and Social Welfare
The Ministry of Finance
The Ministry of Economic Affairs and Development Planning.
- (ii) During the build-up period of four years representatives for Denmark as follows:
The Danish Ambassador to Tanzania or his representative
A representative for the Danish International Development Agency (DANIDA).

(b) The Chairman of the Board shall be appointed by the Government of Tanzania.

(c) The Board shall consider and decide on the annual production programme and annual budget of the Institute to be submitted to the Board by the Director of the Institute. It shall furthermore make decisions on matters of policy regarding the objectives and functions of the Institute within the limitations laid down in Article I.

(d) The Board shall meet at least once a year and more frequently if the activities of the Institute so requires. Further details regarding the rules of procedure of the Board shall be decided by the Board itself.

(e) The Chief Technical Adviser/Project Manager and the Director of the Institute may attend the meetings.

Article VIII

A technical advisory committee shall be set up and meet regularly to discuss ways and means to realise the objectives of the Institute and to co-ordinate its activities with other institutions in Tanzania in the field of education. The committee shall comprise an educational expert from each of the following ministries:

Ministry of Information and Broadcasting
Ministry of National Education
Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Co-operatives
Ministry of Regional Administration and Rural Development
Ministry of Health and Social Welfare.

The Director of the Institute and Chief Technical Adviser/Project Manager shall be members of the committee.

RIGHTS AND EXEMPTIONS

Article IX

The legal position of Danish staff members and their dependents shall be in conformity with the provisions of the Agreement on Scientific and Technical Co-operation between the Government of Denmark and the Government of the United Republic of Tanzania signed at Dar es Salaam on April 5, 1967¹.

ENTRY INTO FORCE, AMENDMENT AND DURATION

Article X

This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of its signature and remain in force for five years from that day, but may be extended by mutual agreement between the two parties.

Article XI

This Agreement may be amended by exchange of letters between the contracting parties hereto. Each of the contracting parties shall give full and sympathetic consideration to any request by the other for such modification.

Article XII

On expiry of this Agreement, the equipment supplied by Denmark shall become the property of the Government of Tanzania. The Government of Tanzania will then from its own sources carry on the activities of the Institute.

Article XIII

Either contracting party may terminate this Agreement prior to the date of expiry by giving six month's written notice to the other party of its intention to terminate the Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the undersigned being duly authorised by their respective Governments have signed the present Agreement.
