SPECIAL CENTRAL AMERICAN AGREEMENT¹ ON THE EQUALIZATION OF IMPORT DUTIES ON TEXTILES MANUFACTURED FROM RAYON OR FROM OTHER ARTIFICIAL OR SYNTHETIC FIBRES

The Governments of the Republics of Guatemala, El Salvador, Honduras, Nicaragua and Costa Rica,

CONSIDERING that it has not been possible to agree upon a standard tariff for textiles manufactured from rayon or from other artificial or synthetic fibres in accordance with the principle established in article XIV of the Central American Agreement on the Equalization of Import Duties and Charges;² and

CONSIDERING that it is necessary further to reduce the differences in the tariff levels applying to the imports of garment manufacturing enterprises;

HAVE DECIDED to sign this Special Agreement, and for that purpose have appointed as their respective plenipotentiaries:

H.E. The Head of Government of the Republic of Guatemala: Carlos Enrique Peralta Méndez, Minister for Economic Affairs;

H.E. The President of the Republic of El Salvador: Abelardo Torres, Minister for Economic Affairs;

H.E. The Head of Government of the Republic of Honduras: Cupertino Núñez M., Under-Secretary for Economic and Financial Affairs;

H.E. The President of the Republic of Nicaragua: Jorge Armijo Mejía, Vice-Minister for Economic Affairs;

H.E. The President of the Republic of Costa Rica: Bernal Jiménez Monge, Minister for Economic and Financial Affairs,

who, having exchanged their full powers, found to be in good and due form, have agreed as follows:

Article I

The Contracting States agree to modify through this Special Agreement Schedule B of the San José Protocol¹ to the Central American Agreement on the Equalization of Import Duties and Charges by adopting a tariff equivalent to three dollars and fifty cents per gross kilogramme and 10 per cent *ad valorem* c.i.f., to be reached in a period of not more than five years, commencing on 29 April 1964, in respect of the products appearing in sub-subitems 01, 02 and 03 of each of the subitems 653-05-02, 653-05-03, 653-05-04 and 653-05-05.

Article II

Annex I to this Agreement, which forms an integral part of it, shows the tariffs to be applied by the Contracting Parties to the imported textiles referred to in the subitems enumerated in the preceding article during each year of the transition period.

Article III

Annex II to this Agreement shows the tariffs which the Contracting Parties shall apply during each year of the transition period to the same textiles imported by enterprises which, in the opinion of the national administrative authorities, employ industrial processes to the manufacture of garments. These imports shall be authorized in the quantities required, in accordance with the output of such enterprises.

Article IV

Except as provided in this Agreement, the procedure for determining the annual decrease or increase in tariffs during the transition period contained in the fifth paragraph of article XIV of the Central American Agreement on the Equalization of Import Duties and Charges shall remain in force.

All of the other provisions of the Central American Agreement on the Equalization of Import Duties and Charges shall apply to this Agreement.

Article V

This Agreement shall be submitted by each State for ratification in conformity with its constitutional and legal procedures and shall enter into force, for the first three countries to deposit the instrument of ratification, on the date of deposit of the third such instrument, and, for countries acceding thereafter, on the date of deposit of their respective instruments of ratification.

Article VI

The present Agreement shall be deposited with the General Secretariat of the Organization of Central American States, which shall send certified copies to the Ministries of Foreign Affairs of each of the Contracting States and to the Permanent Secretariat of the General Treaty on Central American Economic Integration,¹ and shall also promptly notify them of the deposit of each of the instruments of ratification. Upon the entry into force of the Agreement, it shall also transmit a certified copy to the Secretariat of the United Nations for registration in conformity with Article 102 of the United Nations Charter.

Article VII

The duration of the present Agreement shall be contingent upon that of the Central American Agreement on the Equalization of Import Duties and Charges.

The Contracting States agree to establish and adopt progressively the standard duty specified in column III. This standard duty shall be reached at the end of the transition period shown in column I. They likewise agree to initiate equalization, starting from the tariff appearing in column II, and to adjust it where necessary to the annual increases or decreases until the required standard duty is reached.
