EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRE-LAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF CHILE CONCERNING A DEVELOPMENT LOAN BY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM TO THE GOVERNMENT OF CHILE TOWARDS THE COST OF A NUCLEAR RESEARCH REACTOR

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the recent discussions concerning development aid from the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the Government of the Republic of Chile and to inform Your Excellency that the Government of the United Kingdom are prepared to conclude an agreement with the Government of Chile in the following terms. The position of the Government of the United Kingdom with regard to the provision of finance and the commitments of that Government and of the Government of Chile as regards associated matters shall be as respectively set out in part A and part B below:

A. The Government of the United Kingdom declare that it is their intention, acting by the Ministry of Overseas Development (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry"), to make available to the Government of Chile by way of a loan a sum not exceeding $\pounds75,000$ (seventy-five thousand pounds sterling) towards the cost of a nuclear research reactor.

B. (1) The Government of the United Kingdom shall adopt the arrangements and procedures described in the following paragraphs of this note in so far as they relate to things to be done by or on behalf of that Government. The Government of Chile shall adopt the arrangements and procedures so described in so far as they relate to things to be done by or on behalf of that Government.

(2) (a) For the purposes of these arrangements the Government of Chile shall, by a request in the form set out in annex A to this note, open a special account (hereinafter referred to as "the Account") with a bank in London (hereinafter referred to as "the Bank"). The Account shall be operated solely for the purposes of the loan and in accordance with the instructions contained in the said request.

b) As soon as the Account is opened and before taking any other step required by these arrangements for obtaining any part of the loan, the Government of Chile shall furnish the Ministry with a copy of the Government's instructions to the Bank given in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this paragraph. The Government of Chile shall at the same time and so often as any change is made therein, notify the Ministry of the names of the officers who are duly authorized to sign on its behalf the Payment Authorities and Requests for Drawing hereinafter provided and shall furnish a specimen signature in duplicate of each such officer.

(c) The Government of Chile shall ensure that the Bank forwards monthly to the Ministry a statement of payments into and from the Account.

(d) Unless the Ministry otherwise agree, payments into the Account shall not be made after the 31st of March, 1969.

(3) Save to the extent (if any) to which the Ministry may otherwise agree, drawings from the loan shall be used only for payments under a contract for the purchase in the United Kingdom (which expressions in this note shall be deemed to include the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man) of equipment wholly produced or manufactured in the United Kingdom or for work to be done or for services to be rendered by persons ordinarily resident or carrying on business in the United Kingdom or for two or more of such purposes, being a contract which:

- (a) provides for payment in sterling to persons carrying on business in the United Kingdom; and
- (b) is approved on behalf of the Government of Chile and accepted by the Ministry for financing from the loan; and
- (c) is a contract entered into after the 1st of January, 1969.

(4) (a) Where the Government of Chile proposes that part of the loan shall be applied to a contract, that Government shall ensure that there are forwarded at the earliest opportunity to the Ministry:

- (i) a copy of the contract; and
- (ii) two copies of a certificate from the contractor concerned in the United Kingdom in the form set out in annex B to this note.

(b) The Government of Chile shall ensure that the Ministry is informed if at any time a contract (being a contract in respect of which documents have been forwarded in accordance with the foregoing provisions) is amended or if liability is incurred or is to be incurred thereunder to a greater or lesser amount than the amount specified in the relevant documents so forwarded; and in any of these cases the Government of Chile shall ensure that there are forwarded as soon as possible to the Ministry the relevant supplementary or revised documents.

(5) (a) After the Ministry has considered the documents forwarded, in respect of any contract in pursuance of the procedure described in the foregoing provisions of this note, and any additional information which it may request from the Government of Chile for this purpose (and which that Government shall then supply) the Ministry shall notify that Government in the form set out in annex B (i) to this note whether and to what extent it accepts that a contract is eligible for payment from the loan.

(b) To the extent that the Ministry so accepts a contract and agrees to payment from the Account, it shall, on receipt of a request from the Government of Chile, in the form set out in annex C to this note, giving details of the payment due and about to be made, make payments in sterling into the Account and each such payment shall constitute a drawing on the loan.

(6) For payments due under a contract to which paragraph (3) refers withdrawals from the Account shall be made in accordance with Payment Authorities in the form shown in annex D hereto signed on behalf of the Government of Chile and countersigned by the Ministry. Each Payment Authority shall be forwarded in duplicate to the Ministry for countersignature and shall be accompanied by Payment Certificates from the Contractors concerned in the form shown in annex E hereto and the invoices (or a photo-copy or duplicate of such invoices) referred to therein, for retention by the Ministry.

(7) If any monies that have been paid out of the Account are subsequently refunded either by the Contractor or by a guarantor, the Government of Chile shall, so long as there are payments to be made from the Account, pay an equivalent of such sums into the Account and, in any other case, apply the refund to the reduction of the loan.

(8) The Government of Chile shall repay to the Ministry in pounds sterling in London the total sum borrowed under the arrangements set out in this Note, such repayment to be made by instalments paid on the dates and in the amounts specified below; except that if, on the date when any such instalment is due to be paid, there is then outstanding less than the amount specified for that instalment, only the amount then outstanding shall be paid:

(9) The Government of Chile shall pay to the Ministry in pounds sterling in London interest on drawings from the loan in accordance with the following provisions.

(a) The rate of interest in respect of each drawing shall be $7 \frac{3}{4}\%$.

(b) Interest shall be calculated in respect of each drawing on a day-to-day basis on the balance of the loan for the time being outstanding.

(c) Interest shall be paid on the 30th of June and on the 31st of December in each year.

(10) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (8) of this note, the Government of Chile shall be free at any earlier time to repay to the Ministry in pounds sterling in London the whole or any part of the loan that is still outstanding, together with the accrued interest thereon calculated as in paragraph (9) above up to the date of payment.

2. If the foregoing is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Chile, I have the honour to suggest that the present note together with Your Excellency's reply in that sense shall constitute an agreement between the two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply, and the Agreement shall be referred to as the United Kingdom/Chile Loan 1969.

3. I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurances of my highest consideration.

I have to request you on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Chile (hereinafter called "the Government") to open an account in the name of the Government to be styled the United Kingdom/Chile Loan 1969 Account (hereinafter called "the Account").

2. Payments into the Account may be made from time to time by the Ministry of Overseas Development of Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (hereinafter called "the Ministry"). It is possible that, as a result of refunds becoming due from contractors, payments into the Account will also be made by the Government itself.

3. Payments from the Account are to be made only against Payment Authorities in the form marked "D" attached hereto duly signed on behalf of the Government and countersigned on behalf of the Ministry.

4. You are to send to the Ministry at the end of each month a detailed statement showing all debits and credits to the Account during the month.

5. You will notify the Chilean Embassy in London from time to time of the amount required to be drawn from the loan so that the amount so drawn, together with any balance which may be available in the Account, will be sufficient to cover the total value of payments due under Payment Authorities duly signed on behalf of the Government and countersigned on behalf of the Ministry.
