EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT ¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRIT-AIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE STATE OF BAHRAIN AND ITS DEPENDENCIES CONCERNING THE TERMINATION OF SPECIAL TREATY RELATIONS BETWEEN THE SAID STATES

Her Majesty's Political Resident at Bahrain to His Highness the Ruler of Bahrain and its Dependencies

BRITISH RESIDENCY BAHRAIN

15 August, 1971

Your Highness,

I have the honour to refer to the discussions which have taken place between Your Highness and myself concerning the termination of the special treaty relations between the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the State of Bahrain and its Dependencies and to the desire of Your Highness's Government that the State of Bahrain should resume full international responsibility as a sovereign and independent State. On behalf of the Government of the United Kingdom I now propose that:

- (1) The special treaty relations between the United Kingdom and the State of Bahrain, which are inconsistent with full international responsibility as a sovereign and independent State, shall terminate with effect from today's date.
- (2) The exclusive agreements of 22 December 1880 and of 13 March 1892 and all other agreements, engagements, undertakings and arrangements between the United Kingdom and the State of Bahrain flowing from the special treaty relations between the two States shall terminates with effect from the same date.
- (3) The relations between the United Kingdom and the State of Bahrain shall continue to be governed by a spirit of close friendship and co-opera-

tion, and to this end a treaty of friendship ¹ concerning the future relations between the two States shall be signed.

If the foregoing proposals are acceptable to Your Highness's Government, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and Your Highness's reply to that effect, shall be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on today's date.

I avail myself on this opportunity to renew to Your Highness the assurances of my highest consideration.
