SPECIAL AGREEMENT 1 TRANSFERRING THE POWERS OF THE COMMUNITY TO THE CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC

The Government of the French Republic and The Government of the Central African Republic Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

The Central African Republic, in full agreement and friendship with the French Republic, shall accede to international sovereignty and independence through the transfer of the powers of the Community.

Article 2

All the powers established by article 78 of the Constitution of 4 October 1958 shall be transferred to the Central African Republic in so far as they concern it.

Article 3

Each Contracting Party shall notify the other of the completion of the procedures required under its Constitution for the entry into force of this Agreement, which shall take effect on the date of the last notification.
