## Excellency:

I have the honor to refer to recent conversations between the representatives of our two Governments regarding the loan of the submarine Scabbard Fish (SS-397).

The loan of the submarine Scabbard Fish (SS-397) was made pursuant to the agreements between the Government of the United States of America and the Royal Hellenic Government effected by the exchange of notes dated April 4 and 14, 1962, <sup>2</sup> and the exchange of notes dated December 15, 1958, and January 15, 1959.<sup>3</sup> The loan of this submarine was scheduled to expire on February 26, 1970.

I have the honor to inform Your Excellency that, in response to the request of the Royal Hellenic Government, the Government of the United States agrees to extend the loan of the submarine for another period of five years, not exceeding ten years from the original date of delivery under the terms and conditions of the agreements referred to above pertaining to the submarine, as expressly further amended by this agreement. Accordingly, the new expiration date of this loan will be as follows:

Notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary in the agreements referred to above, the loan of the submarine *Scabbard Fish* (SS-397) may be terminated by either Government at any time.

If the foregoing is acceptable to the Royal Hellenic Government, I have the honor further to propose that Your Excellency's reply to that effect and my note shall together constitute an agreement between our two Governments regarding this matter, which shall enter into force on the date of Your Excellency's reply.
