SPECIAL AGREEMENT ON THE CONDITIONS FOR THE PARTICIPATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF CHAD IN THE COMMUNITY

The Government of the French Republic and

The Government of the Republic of Chad,

Considering that, by virtue of the transfer agreement of 12 July 1960,² which entered into force on 10 August 1960, the Republic of Chad has acceded to independence and that the French Republic has recognized it as an independent and sovereign State,

Considering that the Republic of Chad has stated its intention to cooperate with the French Republic within the Community,

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

The Republic of Chad shall be a member of the Community and shall participate in it under the conditions laid down in this Agreement and in co-operation agreements.

Article 2

The Republic of Chad shall recognize that the President of the French Republic is de jure the President of the Community.

Article 3

The French Republic and the Republic of Chad shall participate in a periodic Conference of Heads of State and Government presided over by the President of the Community in order to work together on the main problems affecting the Community.

They shall also participate in committees of ministers or experts in which the other States may be represented.

Article 4

The Republic of Chad shall have the right to send a delegation to an Interparliamentary Consultative Senate composed of delegates of the legislative assemblies of the States of the Community.

Article 5

Each Contracting Party shall notify the other of the completion of the procedures constitutionally required for the entry into force of this Agreement, which shall take effect on the date of the last notification.
