EXCHANGE OF LETTERS CONSTITUTING AN AGREE-MENT' BETWEEN THE FRENCH REPUBLIC AND THE GABONESE REPUBLIC ON CONTROL OF THE CHART-ERING OF FOREIGN SHIPS

The Prime Minister of the French Republic to the Prime Minister of the Gabonese Republic

Libreville, 17 August 1960

Sir,

Our two Governments have agreed to co-operate in matters relating to the merchant marine.<sup>2</sup> Such co-operation is to be effected, *inter alia*, through control of the chartering of foreign ships.

For the purposes of such control, the establishment of an efficient, flexible and expeditious procedure is desirable.

Consequently, I have the honour to propose to you that the competent Gabonese and French departments should consult each other before granting permits for the chartering of foreign ships with a view to determining whether ships flying either of our flags are available for the services for which such permits are requested.
