## AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF FINLAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE GERMAN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS

The Government of the Republic of Finland and the Government of the German Democratic Republic have agreed to exchange diplomatic representatives having the rank of Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary in accordance with the generally recognized rules of international law laid down in the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961.<sup>2</sup>

This Agreement shall enter into force 30 days after the date of its signature.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the plenipotentiaries of the Contracting Parties have signed this Agreement and have thereto affixed their seals.

DONE at Helsinki on 8 December 1972, in duplicate in the Finnish and German languages, both texts being equally authentic.
