EXCHANGE OF LETTERS CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF DENMARK AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF BANGLADESH REGARDING A GRANT OF TELECOMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT BY THE GOVERNMENT OF DENMARK TO THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF BANGLADESH

I ROYAL DANISH EMBASSY

Dacca, August 15, 1972

Sir,

With reference to our discussions and correspondence regarding a grant of telecommunication equipment by the Government of Denmark to the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, I have the honour to propose that the following provisions shall govern the transfer of the grant:

- I. Subject to the following provisions and such other provisions as may be agreed upon between the Parties, the Government of Denmark shall make available to the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh telecommunication equipment to a value of approximately 7 million Danish kroner.
- II. The consignment will include the equipment or equipment similar to the items mentioned in the attached list.
- III. The Danish International Development Agency will purchase the equipment and deliver the same c.i.f. at Chittagong or Chalna port. The consignment will be addressed to:

The Ministry of Post, Telegraph and Telephone, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh.

- At least one month prior to the arrival of the goods the Danish International Development Agency will forward to the said Ministry the consignment note and the shipping bill.
- IV. The Ministry of Post, Telegraph and Telephone will undertake all expenses involved in the clearance of the goods and their transport inside Bangladesh. It will also make arrangement for the prompt delivery and distribution of the goods.
- V. At the completion of the distribution the Ministry of Post, Telegraph and Telephone will submit a report to the Danish International Development Agency regarding the utilization of the equipment supplied by the Government of Denmark.

If the foregoing provisions are acceptable to the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, I have the honour to suggest that this letter and your reply to it constitute an agreement between our two Governments on this matter.
