AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup> BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF SWEDEN AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF NORWAY CONCERNING THE EXCHANGE OF MILITARY INFORMATION AND MATERIAL

The Government of the Kingdom of Sweden and the Government of the Kingdom of Norway have found it desirable to promote the development, production, procurement and the like of defence material, *inter alia*, through reciprocal and joint purchases whenever possible.

To that end, the two Governments shall, where appropriate, authorize their respective authorities to communicate to each other such military information and deliver such material as may create the necessary conditions for joint procurement, development and the like.

Where secret military information is communicated or secret military material is delivered, the following shall apply:

- (a) The information and material received may not be delivered to third parties without the consent of the country of origin.
- (b) The information and material received shall be given at least the same degree of security protection in the recipient country as in the country of origin.
- (c) The information and material received may not be used for purposes other than those provided for.

Proprietary rights, such as patents, copyrights, trade secrets and the like, which relate to the military information communicated and the material delivered shall be respected and protected in accordance with the applicable law.

Details regarding communication, handling and the like, in connexion with the exchange of military information and material provided for herein, shall be specified in a special agreement between the competent authorities of the two countries.

This Agreement may be reviewed at any time at the request of either Government and shall cease to have effect six months after either Government has denounced it in writing to the other. Such denunciation shall, however, not affect obligations which have arisen by reason of the provisions of the Agreement.

This Agreement shall enter into force upon the date of its signature.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the undersigned, being duly authorized to do so by their respective Governments, have signed this Agreement and have thereto affixed their seals.

DONE at Stockholm on 19 May 1969, in duplicate in the Swedish and Norwegian languages, both texts being equally authentic.
