POSTAL AND TELECOMMUNICATION MATTERS  
CONVENTION<sup>1</sup>

---

*Sole article.* Relations in respect of postal and telecommunication matters between the French Republic and the Malagasy Republic shall be governed by the Acts of the Universal Postal Union and of the International Telecommunication Union.

Such relations may also be determined by supplementary agreements or by exchanges of letters establishing preferential relations between the postal and telecommunication administrations of the two countries.
