STATE PROPERTY MATTERS
CONVENTION¹

Article 1. The French State shall transfer to the Malagasy State ownership of the real property appearing on the list annexed to this Convention.

Article 2. To enable the French State to ensure the functioning of its services in Madagascar, the Malagasy State shall grant it temporary possession of the property concerned.

The conditions for such possession shall be established by agreement between the two Governments.

Article 3. When the property referred to in the foregoing article is no longer required for the functioning of French services, possession thereof shall revert *pleno jure* to the Malagasy State, to which the property shall be returned.

P R O T O C O L

1. Possession of the real property referred to in article 1 of the Convention concerning State property matters shall be free of charge.

2. The French State shall have possession, under the conditions currently in effect, of the properties housing consular posts (chancellery and places of residence) for a period of one year beginning on 25 January 1973, having due regard to the provisions of the Exchange of Letters with respect to foreign policy.

3. The conditions for possession referred to in paragraph 1 of this Protocol and, in particular, the duration of such possession may be reviewed annually by the Parties in the light of their respective needs through the mixed commission provided for in article 5 of the General Agreement.

4. This Protocol shall enter into force on the same date as the General Agreement.
