### EXCHANGE OF LETTERS CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT' BE-TWEEN THE FRENCH REPUBLIC AND THE MALAGASY REPUBLIC CONCERNING FOREIGN POLICY

Ι

Paris, 4 June 1973

Sir.

Inasmuch as the agreements on co-operation between the French Republic and the Malagasy Republic concluded on 27 June 1960<sup>2</sup> are considered abrogated as from 25 January 1973, the Government of the Malagasy Republic proposes for the approval of the Government of the French Republic the following provisions with respect to foreign policy:

- 1. Each of the Contracting Parties shall accredit an ambassador to the other Contracting Party.
- 2. The seats and consular districts of consular posts in the territory of each of the two States shall be specified by agreement between the two Governments at the end of a period of one year from 25 January 1973. Until that date, the Franco-Malagasy Consular Convention of 25 April 1963 shall continue to apply.

Upon the expiry of the said period, Franco-Malagasy consular relations shall be governed by the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 24 April 1963.<sup>3</sup>

3. The two States, having regard to the bonds of friendship which link them, agree to consult each other whenever necessary on matters of common interest and to exchange their views on current international problems.

I have the honour to request you to inform me whether the French Government approves these proposals, which would enter into force on the same date as the General Agreement.
