AGREEMENT¹ ON ECONOMIC, INDUSTRIAL, SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE KINGDOM OF DENMARK AND THE ARAB REPUBLIC OF EGYPT

The Government of the Kingdom of Denmark and the Government of the Arab Republic of Egypt

desirous of further strengthening the friendly relations between the two countries,

confirming their interest in supporting and facilitating the continued development of economic, industrial, scientific and technical co-operation between the two countries to their mutual advantage,

recognizing the great significance of such co-operation and desiring to create the most appropriate conditions for its development,

have agreed as follows:

Article 1. The Contracting Parties shall encourage and develop the economic, industrial, scientific and technical co-operation between the two countries.

Article 2. The Contracting Parties shall define the fields in which they consider the broadening of co-operation to be useful. They recognize that possibilities for co-operation should be explored and utilized i.a. in the following fields:

- a) co-operation on projects of common interest, including license and know-how arrangements between Danish and Egyptian enterprises in the two countries and on third markets,
- b) studies and visits, with a view to the implementation of common projects,
- c) arranging of courses and conferences,
- d) exchange of specialists and trainees,
- e) exchange of technical documentation and information.

Article 3. The conditions governing particular projects of economic, industrial, scientific and technological co-operation shall be agreed between the respective organizations, enterprises and firms of the two countries, in accordance with the laws and regulations in force in the two countries.

Article 4. The Contracting Parties establish a Joint Commission on economic, industrial, scientific and technical co-operation composed of representatives of the two countries.

The Joint Commission shall:

- supervise the implementation of this agreement and in this connection endeavour to remove possible obstacles encountered in the course of the implementation of the agreement,
- consider proposals presented by either side, aimed at supporting and developing the economic, industrial, scientific and technical co-operation between the two countries,
- make recommendations for measures to be taken for the successful implementation of the agreement.

At the request of either Party the Commission shall meet alternately in Denmark and Egypt.

Article 5. The country sending out specialists and trainees will pay all expenses incidental to travel to and from the receiving country as well as board and lodging during the stay, if the organizations concerned have not made other arrangements.

In order to ensure the greatest possible mutual benefit, work programmes for specialists and for courses and conferences for specialists shall be available in due time before any such visits or arrangements begin.

Article 6. This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of signature. It remains in force as long as it is not terminated by one of the Contracting Parties with a notice of six months. Any such termination shall have no effect on the fulfilment of contracts and arrangements made under the provisions of the present Agreement.
