GENERAL CULTURAL AGREEMENT¹

With a view to developing intellectual relations in the field of education between the French Republic and the Persian Empire, it has been agreed as follows:

Article 1. Persians holding a secondary school leaving certificate issued by the Persian Ministry of Education shall be admitted to French universities without further examination.

Article 2. They shall be admitted to take the same courses and to apply for the same degrees and diplomas as students holding the French general certificate of secondary education.

Article 3. However, such students may not enrol in courses leading to the State degrees and diplomas of doctor of medicine, pharmacist and dental surgeon without establishing that they hold the French certificates required under the laws and regulations; on the other hand, they may apply for diplomas conferred by the Universities that officially recognize that they have completed the same courses.

Article 4. Subject to the above reservation, no distinction shall be made from the academic point of view between Persian and French students.

Article 5. A technical committee may be set up to study questions affecting scientific and scholastic relations between the two countries and to propose to their Governments suitable measures for promoting such relations.
