AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL
REPUBLIC OF GERMANY AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE RE-
PUBLIC OF SRI LANKA CONCERNING FINANCIAL ASSIST-
ANCE

The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany and the Government of the Republic of Sri Lanka,

In the spirit of the friendly relations existing between the Federal Republic of Germany and the Republic of Sri Lanka,

Desiring to strengthen and intensify those friendly relations by fruitful co-operation in the field of development assistance,

Aware that the maintenance of those relations constitutes the basis of the present Agreement,

Intending to contribute to economic and social development in the Republic of Sri Lanka,

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1. The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany shall enable the Government of the Republic of Sri Lanka or another borrower to be jointly selected by the two Governments to raise with the *Kreditanstalt für Wiederaufbau* (Development Loan Corporation), Frankfurt/Main, a loan up to 6,500,000 DM (six million, five hundred thousand German Marks) to meet foreign exchange costs resulting from the purchase of goods and services to cover current civilian requirements. These supplies and services must be such as are covered by the list annexed to the present Agreement and for which import licences have been issued after 31 May 1976.

Article 2. (1) The utilization of the loan as well as the terms and conditions on which it is granted shall be governed by the provisions of the agreements to be concluded between the borrower and the *Kreditanstalt für Wiederaufbau*, which shall be subject to the laws and regulations applicable in the Federal Republic of Germany.

(2) The Government of the Republic of Sri Lanka, to the extent that it is not itself the borrower, and the Central Bank of the Republic of Sri Lanka shall guarantee to the *Kreditanstalt für Wiederaufbau* all payments in German Marks to be made in fulfilment of the borrower's liabilities under the agreements to be concluded pursuant to paragraph 1 above.

Article 3. The Government of the Republic of Sri Lanka shall exempt the *Kreditanstalt für Wiederaufbau* from all taxes and other public charges levied in the Republic of Sri Lanka at the time of the conclusion, or during the implementation, of the agreements referred to in article 2 of the present Agreement.

Article 4. The Government of the Republic of Sri Lanka shall allow passengers and suppliers free choice of transport enterprises for such transportation by land, sea or air of persons and goods as results from the granting of the loan, abstain from taking any measures that might exclude or impair the participation on equal terms of transport enterprises having their place of business in the German area of

application of the present Agreement, and grant permits for such participation as required.

Article 5. With regard to supplies resulting from the granting of the loan, the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany attaches particular importance to preference being given to products of industries of Land Berlin.

Article 6. With the exception of those provisions of article 4 which refer to air transport, this Agreement shall also apply to Land Berlin, provided that the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany does not make a contrary declaration to the Government of the Republic of Sri Lanka within three months of the date of entry into force of this Agreement.

Article 7. The present Agreement shall enter into force on the date of signature thereof.

DONE at Colombo on 29 October 1976 in duplicate in the German, Sinhala and English languages, all three texts being equally authentic.

ANNEX TO THE AGREEMENT OF 29 OCTOBER 1976 BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA CONCERNING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

List of goods and services which may be purchased by the Republic of Sri Lanka under article 1 of the Agreement referred to above in the amount of 6,500,000 DM (six million, five hundred thousand German Marks):

1. Equipment and vehicles for the Geological Survey Department;
2. Machinery, equipment and spare parts for activities in connection with Port operations;
3. Industrial equipment, spare parts, and accessories for the petroleum, cement and paper industries in Sri Lanka, induction furnace for Enderamulla Foundry;
4. Industrial equipment as well as agricultural machinery and implements, accessories and spares;
5. Chemical products for the industrial and agricultural sectors;
6. Industrial auxiliaries and raw materials related to industrial development in Sri Lanka;
7. Any other item to be mutually agreed upon between the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany and the Government of the Republic of Sri Lanka;
8. The costs, also in national currency, of transport, insurance and assembly arising in connection with the importation of goods financed under the present Agreement.

Imports not included in the above list may only be financed with the prior approval of the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany.

The importation of consumer goods for personal needs, especially luxury goods, as well as any goods and facilities serving military purposes, may not be financed from the loan.
