Dear Mr. Prime Minister:

In order to have the clearest possible mutual understanding about the status of United States personnel who are being assigned temporarily to Dominica, my Government has asked that I confirm with your Government that the engineering personnel of the U.S. Department of Defense temporarily in Dominica for the purpose of emergency repairs shall be accorded the privileges and immunities normally extended to the administrative and technical staff of a diplomatic mission under the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations² and customary international law.

If the above understanding is acceptable to the Government of Dominica, this letter and your reply shall constitute an agreement between our two governments.

I take this occasion, Mr. Prime Minister, to reiterate assurances of my highest consideration and personal esteem.
