EXCHANGE OF NOTES1 BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF PAKISTAN CON-STITUTING THE UNITED KINGDOM/PAKISTAN RETRO-SPECTIVE TERMS AGREEMENT 1979

Sir,

United Kingdom/Pakistan Retrospective Terms Agreement 1979

- I have the honour to inform you that, following the announcement by the Government of the United Kingdom on 31 July 1978, and subsequent discussions between my Government and the Government of Pakistan, my Government shall provide assistance to your Government in accordance with the recommendations of the Trade and Development Board (TDB) of UNCTAD. Retrospective adjustment shall be made to the terms of all the loans set out in the Schedules to this Note, which were provided as Official Development Assistance (ODA) and on which there were outstanding repayments of capital and payments of interest (hereinafter called "loan payments") on 31 July 1978.
- The following paragraphs of this Note set out the nature of, and procedures for, the assistance to be given. For the purposes of this Agreement, the eligible loans shall be divided into two groups:
- i. Loans provided under the 1966 Overseas Aid Act, Colonial Development and Welfare Schemes and other legislation and set out in Schedule 1 to this Note:
- ii. Loans provided by the Export Credits Guarantee Department (ECGD) under Credit Agreements and set out in Schedule 2 to this Note.

The amounts and the phasing of such Loan Payments, which are in accordance with the United Kingdom/Pakistan Debt Relief Agreement 1976,2 are set out in Schedule 3 to this Note.

- Unless our Governments agree otherwise, my Government shall waive all loan payments due on or after 31 July 1978, on the date that such payments fall due, on each Schedule 1 loan and each Schedule 2 Credit Agreement.
- The terms and conditions of each loan shall otherwise continue to 4. subsist.
- Any loan payment due between 31 July 1978 and today's date inclusive, and made by your Government, on either Schedule 1 loans or Schedule 2 Credit Agreements shall be refunded by my Government. Payment shall be made on receipt, and approval by my Government, of a request for payment as set out in Appendix A to this Note.
- Loan payments due before 31 July 1978 but paid on or after that date shall not be refunded by my Government. Any loan payments due before 31 July 1978 and still outstanding shall be paid by your Government.

If these proposals are acceptable to the Government of Pakistan I have the honour to propose that the present Note together with your reply in that sense shall constitute an Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom and the Government of Pakistan in this matter and shall be known as the United Kingdom/Pakistan Retrospective Terms Agreement 1979.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to you, Sir, the assurance of my highest consideration.
