EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup> BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND JAPAN RELATING TO THE REPROCESSING OF SPECIAL NUCLEAR MATERIAL

I

The Department of State refers the Embassy of Japan to the Joint Communiqué issued on September 12, 1977, and the Joint Determination on September 12, 1977,<sup>2</sup> for reprocessing of special nuclear material of United States origin and wishes to inform the latter as follows:

- In view of the fact that the term of the International Nuclear Fuel Cycle Evaluation (INFCE) has been extended until the end of February 1980, the Government of the United States of America considers it appropriate that, accordingly, the initial period of operation of the Tokai Reprocessing Facility as referred to in the aforementioned communiqué be extended until April 30, 1980.
- 2. The Government of the United States of America reaffirms that the actions of the two countries in the extended period mentioned in paragraph 1 above should be guided by the understandings, principles and intentions set out in the aforementioned Joint Communiqué, and based on the aforementioned Joint Determination.
