MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING' BETWEEN CANADA AND THE UNITED STATES REGARDING THE STAGING OF CER-TAIN TARIFF REDUCTIONS

The Governments of Canada and the United States agree to accelerated implementation of certain of their MTN tariff concessions, in consecutive annual staged reductions, commencing on January 1, 1980. These concession items are specified in the attached annexes:

-Annex A: Canadian Tariff Reductions: Proposed Phasing Modifications.

-Annex B: U.S.A. Tariff Reductions: Proposed Phasing Modifications.

Implementation of the agreed staging by Canada and the United States of tariff concessions on live cattle is contingent upon conclusion of U.S. negotiations with Mexico and confirmation of the United States offer to reduce its tariff on TSUS 100.45 (live cattle 200-700 lbs.) This agreement on accelerated staging will be incorporated in the respective GATT schedules of the two parties.²
