Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the discussions held within the framework of the Tokyo Round of Negotiations under the auspices of the Contracting Parties to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade³ and to confirm, on behalf of the Government of Japan, the following offer on peas and beans made by the Delegation of Japan, which will be implemented in accordance with the relevant laws and regulations in Japan, provided that the Geneva (1979) Protocol⁴ will have come into force between the two Parties.

The Japanese Government is prepared to ensure by appropriate means already available to it that the level of the Import Mark-up to be received by the Japan Peas and Beans Import Fund Association will not be raised above the present level (20% of import value).

Note: The above understanding covers items under Statistical Code No. 0705-220, 410, 490.
