NOTE VERBALE

The Federal Ministry for Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to the International Atomic Energy Agency and has the honour to inform the latter that the Federal Chancellery of the Republic of Austria makes the following contribution within the framework of the IAEA's programme for technical cooperation: Cash contribution to the Project Eradication of the Mediterranean Fruit Fly from Egypt in an amount of up to 16,309.000 AS (equivalent of US\$ 1.000.000 as per exchange rate May, 1982) which will be transferred in instalments as indicated below to the account number 75715/00 of IAEA with CA-BV, 1010 Wien, Schottengasse 6, after receipt of the Agency's note of reply agreeing with the content of this Note Verbale.

The transfer of funds shall be effected as follows:

AS 8,200,000 in 1982

AS 4,000.000 [in] mid-1983

AS 4,109.000 after receipt of final report and financial statement and their approval by the Federal Chancellery

It is understood that the IAEA shall:

- (a) Implement the project according to the provisions of the Agreement between IAEA and the Government of Egypt, dated 24 October 1982;³ amendments to that Agreement will affect these arrangements only upon their approval by the Federal Chancellery;
- (b) Assume liability for and shall hold the Austrian Federal Chancellery indemnified against all claims arising out of the execution of the project which may be adduced to the Austrian participation in the project;
- (c) Ensure that the contribution is used economically and for its intended purpose according to the attached document;
- (d) Administer this special-purpose-contribution in accordance with IAEA's financial rules, auditing and other applicable regulations;

- (e) Endeavour to procure equipment manufactured in Austria whenever possible in accordance with its financial rules and regulations;
- (f) Transmit to the Federal Ministry of Foreign Affairs six-monthly progress reports together with a financial report. The reports shall be structured according to the project document and show a break-down of expenditure according to the items enumerated in the Project Document; not later than six months after the completion of the Project a final report including the final accounts shall be presented. This report shall contain an evaluation of the results of the Project.
- (g) Reimburse the surplus amount to the Austrian Federal Chancellery if the funds made available to the Project by the Austrian Federal Chancellery exceed the amount spent by IAEA on the Project.

The Federal Ministry for Foreign Affairs avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the International Atomic Energy Agency the assurances of its highest consideration.
