PROTOCOL¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERATIVE REPUBLIC OF BRAZIL AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED MEXICAN STATES CONCERNING FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR BILATERAL TRADE

The Government of the Federative Republic of Brazil and the Government of the United Mexican States,

Considering the importance of developing trade flows between the two countries as well as of attracting trade to the region,

Considering the desirability of creating the necessary conditions so that such trade flows may proceed as smoothly as possible,

Considering the desire expressed by both Governments to take action designed to strengthen trade and financial links within a comprehensive framework of co-operation,

Have agreed as follows:

Article I. To grant, through their respective specialized institutions, reciprocal lines of credit up to an amount of \$US 50 million to promote exports, on the basis of schemes already established in both countries for the financing of such operations.

Article II. To draw up, as soon as possible, operative technical agreements in order to implement this Protocol, through the Banco do Brasil and the Banco Nacional de Comercio Exterior, S.A. of Mexico.

Article III. This Protocol shall enter into effect on the date of its signature.

DONE at Brasilia on 30 March 1984 in duplicate, in Portuguese and Spanish, both texts being equally authentic.
