AGREEMENT CONCERNING DEVELOPMENT IN THE FIELD OF ANIMAL PRODUCTS

The Government of the United Mexican States, represented by the Secretariat of Agriculture and Water Resources, and the Government of the French Republic, represented by the Ministry of Economic Affairs,

Considering the importance to both countries of animal products,

Aware of the value of improving the organization of the markets for the mutual benefit of producers and consumers,

Desiring to promote co-operation in the production and processing of animal products and products of animal origin, have agreed on the following programme of co-operation:

- Article 1. Joint Mexican-French teams shall be set up to prepare, within a period of three months, analytical surveys and five- and fifteen-year projections relating to the various sectors of livestock production, making use in particular of documentation in the possession of the Mexican party.
- Article 2. On the basis of the analytical surveys, the joint teams shall submit to the Mexican authorities recommendations for the preparation of a short- and medium-term plan which will outline the action to be taken with respect to research, administrative arrangements and investment in order to improve the overall efficiency of the various sectors of livestock production.
- Article 3. For the implementation of this programme, the parties shall define the contractual relationships which are to be established in order to deal with problems arising from staff training, technical assistance and integration of equipment.
