PROTOCOL' BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF BELGIUM AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SAN MARINO ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS

The Government of the Kingdom of Belgium and the Government of the Republic of San Marino,

Considering that excellent consular relations exist between the Kingdom of Belgium and the Republic of San Marino,

Noting with gratification the intention and the desire to strengthen and develop the ties between the two States,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations between the Kingdom of Belgium and the Republic of San Marino and to exchange diplomatic representatives at the rank of Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary,

Have agreed that the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961² shall be applicable to the diplomatic relations between the Kingdom of Belgium and the Republic of San Marino.

This Protocol shall enter into force as soon as the respective Governments have notified each other that all legislative procedures have been completed.

DONE at Brussels on 26 March 1985, in duplicate in the Dutch, French and Italian languages, all three texts being equally authentic.
