ARRANGEMENT¹ CONCERNING THE TERMS OF PARTICIPATION BY THE ITALIAN DEPARTMENT FOR DEVELOPMENT CO-OPERATION IN THE COST OF CONSTRUCTING AND FITTING OUT THE PREFABRICATED WAREHOUSE AT PISA PROVIDED FOR BY THE PREVIOUS ARRANGEMENTS OF 21 DECEMBER 1984²

The Office of the United Nations Disaster Relief Co-ordinator (hereinafter referred to as UNDR0) and the Italian Department for Development Co-operation (hereinafter referred to as the Department),

Considering that, by the Arrangements of 21 December 1984², the Department and UNDR0 have agreed to participate in constructing and fitting out a prefabricated warehouse adjacent to the existing United Nations Supply Depot at Pisa;

Considering that, under article 2 (f) of the said Arrangements, it is agreed that UNDR0 shall authorize the Department, in return for a gradual increase in its contribution, to use the entire warehouse for a period of five years;

Considering that the Department has underscored its need to utilize the entire prefabricated warehouse in order to conduct increasingly frequent and extensive emergency operations which involve the dispatch to the developing countries of foodstuffs, medical supplies and other relief goods and equipment, and that, in view of this need, the Department has expressed its intention to contribute to constructing and fitting out that warehouse, in the amount of 800 million Italian lire;

Considering further that the above-mentioned sum represents a substantial contribution to the cost of constructing and fitting out that warehouse, bearing in mind that the total costs will amount to at least 950 million Italian lire;

Recognizing that the request of the Department can be approved since it is fully in keeping with the requirements of article 2 (f) of the Arrangements of 21 December 1984;

Have agreed as follows:

1. The Department shall grant UNDR0 a special financial contribution of 800 million Italian lire as its share of the cost of constructing and fitting out a prefabricated warehouse at Pisa; this contribution shall include the sum of 150 million Italian lire already deposited to the UNDR0 account at the Banca Commerciale Italiana at Pisa in 1984.

2. In return for this special contribution, UNDR0 shall, in accordance with article 2(f) of the Arrangements of 21 December 1984, authorize the Department to utilize the entire warehouse and its equipment for a period of five years from the completion of the building.

3. With regard to the recurrent operating costs of the prefabricated warehouse, the Department's annual voluntary contribution to UNDR0 for 1985 shall be utilized as follows:

- (a) 300 million Italian lire for UNDR0 overhead costs;
- (b) 200 million Italian lire, on a one-year basis, for general operating expenses as stipulated in the Arrangement of 21 December 1984;
- (c) 100 million Italian lire for costs relating to the additional personnel employed for the Supply Depot at Pisa, as provided in annex A of the Arrangements of 21 December 1984.

4. UNDR0 and the Department undertake to co-operate with each other and to agree on the details deemed useful for the best application of this Arrangement.

This document has been initialled on 1 March 1985 and shall enter into force immediately.
