The Embassy of Turkey presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, External Trade and Development Co-operation and has the honour to propose, on a reciprocal basis, that Turkish and Belgian military aircraft landing at any public civilian airport in Turkey or Belgium operated, respectively, by the General Administration of Turkish State Airports or the Belgian Airways Administration should be exempted from landing charges.

If this proposal is acceptable to the competent Belgian authorities, this note, together with the note conveying the Ministry's approval, shall constitute an agreement on this subject which shall enter into force on the date of the Ministry's note.

The Embassy of Turkey wishes to express its gratitude in advance to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, External Trade and Development Co-operation and takes this opportunity, etc.
