## [TRANSLATION — TRADUCTION]

AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup> BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FRENCH REPUBLIC AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL RE-PUBLIC OF GERMANY CONCERNING A CONTRIBUTION BY THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY TO THE "FRENCH-GERMAN ENTENTE" FOUNDATION

The Government of the French Republic and The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany, In the spirit of French-German entente, Have agreed as follows:

- Article 1. The Federal Republic of Germany shall make a financial contribution to the "French-German Entente" Foundation, whose headquarters is at Strasbourg.
- Article 2. The financial contribution of the Federal Republic of Germany shall be in the amount of 250 million deutsche mark (DM); the contribution shall be paid in three annual instalments, the first of which shall be in an amount of DM 50 million and the other two in an amount of DM 100 million each.
- Article 3. The first instalment shall fall due when this Agreement enters into force, and the second and third instalments in the course of the following two years.
- Article 4. The payments shall be made to the bank account of the Foundation, details of which shall be provided to the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany by the Government of the French Republic.
- Article 5. This Agreement shall also apply to Land Berlin, unless the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany notifies the Government of the French Republic to the contrary within three months after its entry into force.
- Article 6. Each of the Parties shall notify the other of the completion of the constitutional procedures required for the entry into force of this Agreement. The Agreement shall enter into force one month after the date of receipt of the second such notification.

Done at Bonn on 31 March 1981 in duplicate in the French and German languages, both texts being equally authentic.
