AGREEMENT¹ CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A
MIXED HIGH COMMISSION FOR FRANCO-CENTRAL AFRICAN
CO-OPERATION

The Government of the French Republic, on the one hand,
The Government of the Central African Republic, on the other hand,
Considering the ties of friendship uniting their two peoples,
Desiring to promote and develop mutually beneficial co-operation between
their countries,

Considering the need to establish a joint consultative body for the two States,
Have agreed as follows:

Article 1. A Mixed High Commission for Franco-Central African Co-operation shall be established.

Article 2. The terms of operation of this High Commission shall be set forth in an annex.²

DONE at Bangui on 10 July 1982, in two original copies, in the French language, both copies being equally authentic.
