PROTOCOL' OF UNDERSTANDING ON THE PROCEDURE FOR RECOGNITION OF THE VALIDITY OF BACCALAU-(SECONDARY-SCHOOL-LEAVING-CERTIFICATES) AWARDED BY THE REPUBLIC OF DJIBOUTI AND THE FRENCH REPUBLIC

The Government of the French Republic and the Government of the Republic of Diibouti, referring to the Treaty of Friendship and Co-operation between the two States, signed on 27 June 1977,<sup>2</sup> and the Agreement on Co-operation in the Field of Culture and Education between the Government of the French Republic and the Government of the Republic of Diibouti, signed on 26 January 1978, have agreed as follows:

#### Article 1

Recognition of the validity of Djiboutian and French Baccalauréats (secondary-school-leaving-certificates) may be automatically granted on an annual basis by the authorities of both Parties under the conditions laid down in the regulations applicable in the two States.

### Article 2

The provisions of this protocol shall enter into force immediately upon the exchange of instruments in fulfilment of the procedural requirements to be met in each of the two States.

This protocol has been drawn up in duplicate.
