AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE ARGENTINE REPUBLIC AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE SYRIAN ARAB REPUBLIC ON THE CREATION OF AN ARGENTINE-SYRIAN JOINT COMMISSION ON BILATERAL COOPERATION

The Government of the Argentine Republic and the Government of the Syrian Arab Republic,

For the purpose of consolidating and developing economic, commercial, educational, scientific, technical and cultural cooperation and cooperation in tourism between their two countries on the basis of mutual benefit,

Have agreed as follows:

Article I

The two Parties shall create a Joint Commission, hereinafter referred to as "the Joint Commission", to encourage economic, commercial, educational, scientific, technical and cultural cooperation and cooperation in tourism.

Article II

The Joint Commission shall have the following duties:

- (1) To study and implement agreements already signed between the two countries in the field of economic, commercial, educational, scientific, technical and cultural cooperation and cooperation in tourism;
- (2) To explore new possibilities and to make recommendations for the development of economic, commercial, educational, scientific, technical and cultural cooperation and cooperation in tourism between the two countries;
- (3) To facilitate the exchange of information and documentation and bilateral consultations on economic, commercial, educational, scientific, technical, cultural and tourism issues of mutual interest.

Article III

The Joint Commission shall meet at a level to be determined on each occasion; the delegations shall be composed of officials and experts of the two countries.

The Joint Commission shall hold meetings regularly, as it may deem necessary, alternately in Damascus and Buenos Aires.

At the request of either Party and with the consent of the other Party the Joint Commission may hold special meetings if necessary.

Arrangements for the holding of meetings shall be made through the diplomatic channel.

Article IV

The Joint Commission shall adopt its own agenda and shall determine the procedure for the conduct of its work.

Subcommittees created by agreements on specific matters in force between the two countries shall meet under the auspices of the Joint Commission.

The Joint Commission may establish subcommittees and working groups to carry out special tasks.

The records of such subcommittees and working groups shall be subject to the approval of the Joint Commission.

Decisions and recommendations adopted by the Joint Commission shall take effect from the exchange of instruments confirming the approval of the relevant authorities of the two countries.

Article V

This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of signature. It shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years and shall be tacitly renewed for a further period of five (5) years unless one of the Parties gives notice through the diplomatic channel, six (6) months prior to the expiration of such period, of its intention to terminate it.

Done at Buenos Aires on 6 September 1989, in two original copies, each in the Spanish and Arabic languages, both texts being equally authentic.
