PROTOCOL¹ ON INTENDED TRADE COOPERATION BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERATIVE REPUBLIC OF
BRAZIL AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF
ECUADOR

The Government of the Federative Republic of Brazil and

The Government of the Republic of Ecuador,

Inspired by the relations of friendship that exist between the two countries;

Desiring to consolidate and intensify such relations through fruitful cooperation in the field of trade;

Realizing that the maintenance of such relations constitutes the basis for this Protocol;

For the purpose of promoting and increasing the economic and commercial development of the two countries,

Taking into account the experience and infrastructure of Brazilian foreign-trade enterprises,

Agree as follows:

To pursue efforts to apply mechanisms for promoting the expansion of trade flows of Ecuadorian export products, both traditional and non-traditional, to third countries, through the aforementioned enterprises.

This Protocol shall enter into force on the date of its signature.

DONE at Quito on 26 October 1989, in duplicate in the Portuguese and Spanish languages, both texts being equally authentic.
