## AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup> ON ECONOMIC, INDUSTRIAL, TECHNICAL AND SCIENTIFIC COOPERATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF SWEDEN AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA

The Government of the Kingdom of Sweden and the Government of the Republic of Korea (hereinafter referred to as the Contracting Parties),

Being desirous of further strengthening the friendly relations existing between the two countries,

Recognizing the benefits to be derived by both countries from closer economic, industrial, technical and scientific cooperation,

Have agreed as follows:

### *Article 1*

The Contracting Parties shall take all appropriate measures to encourage and promote economic, industrial, technical and scientific cooperation between interested institutions, organizations, enterprises and other parties in the respective countries.

### *Article 2*

The Contracting Parties shall facilitate the exchange of information, trainees and experts in various sectors of science and technology.

### *Article 3*

Forms, modalities and conditions for cooperation within the framework of this Agreement shall be negotiated and agreed on by the institutions, organizations, enterprises and other parties concerned, in accordance with laws and regulations in the respective countries.

### *Article 4*

An Inter-Governmental Joint Commission for Economic, Industrial, Technical and Scientific Cooperation between the Kingdom of Sweden and the Republic of Korea is here-

by established in order to facilitate the implementation of the present Agreement.

The Joint Commission shall consist of representatives of the two Governments and may also include representatives of institutions, organizations, enterprises and other parties of the two countries.

### *Article 5*

The Joint Commission shall review economic, industrial, technical and scientific relations between the Kingdom of Sweden and the Republic of Korea.

In furtherance of these relations the Joint Commission shall seek to identify areas of common interest and to promote the implementation of specific projects and programs. A list of such areas shall be established at the first meeting of the Joint Commission and may be revised whenever appropriate.

### *Article 6*

The Joint Commission shall exchange information and views about subjects falling within its competence and shall encourage and facilitate contacts between industrialists and enterprises in the respective countries.

### *Article 7*

The Joint Commission shall meet alternately in the Kingdom of Sweden and the Republic of Korea at dates agreed upon by the Contracting Parties.

### *Article 8*

This Agreement shall come into force on the date of signature, and shall remain in force for an indefinite period unless terminated upon written notification from either one

of the Contracting Parties. The termination will be effective six months after the date of such notification.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the undersigned, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Agreement.
