PROTOCOL<sup>1</sup> ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE FEDERATIVE REPUBLIC OF BRAZIL AND THE REPUBLIC OF TADJIKISTAN

The Federative Republic of Brazil and the Republic of Tadjikistan,  
confirming their adherence to the aims and principles of the United Nations Charter,

being desirous to strengthen cooperation, mutual understanding and confidence between the Federative Republic of Brazil and the Republic of Tadjikistan,

expressing their aspiration to develop bilateral cooperation on the basis of principles of equality and non-interference into internal affairs of each other,


being guided by the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961,<sup>2</sup>

have agreed to establish Diplomatic Relations between the Federative Republic of Brazil and the Republic of Tadjikistan and exchange representations at the level of Embassies.

The present Protocol enters into force upon its signature.


Done at Moscow on the 29th of March 1996, in two copies, each in the Portuguese, Tadjik and English languages, all texts being equally authentic.
