PROTOCOL<sup>1</sup> ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE FEDERATIVE REPUBLIC OF BRAZIL AND TURKMENISTAN

---

The Federative Republic of Brazil and Turkmenistan,  
Guided by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations,  
Desiring to develop relations of friendship and cooperation between the two countries,

Inspired by the principles of mutual respect for sovereignty, equality, territorial integrity and non-interference in internal affairs,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations as from the date of signature of this Protocol, in accordance with the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961.<sup>2</sup>

The Federative Republic of Brazil and Turkmenistan share the firm conviction that the establishment of diplomatic relations is in the national interest of both States and that it will further the strengthening of world peace and cooperation.

DONE at Moscow on 3 April 1996, in duplicate in the Portuguese and Turkmen languages, both texts being equally authentic.
